Wednesday, June 27, 2012: Mayor Blair Milo announced that there are two (2) emergency cooling centers open to the public during this heat wave. The Fire Station at 115 East Shore Parkway will be open 24 hours per day and City Hall located at 801 Michigan Avenue will be open during business hours: Monday-Friday 8:30pm to 4:30pm.

The Mayor stated, “While everyone is glad that summer is finally here, this heat can be very dangerous. Please take the proper precautions when working outside or in an area with no air conditioning. Drink plenty of fluids and listen to what your body tells you. As always, take a moment to check on your neighbor, the elderly are particularly susceptible to the heat. Don’t hesitate to get to a cooling station if you need one and call 911 in case of emergencies. Don’t forget your pets, they too can suffer in this heat; make sure they have plenty of water and a shaded area to rest in.”
