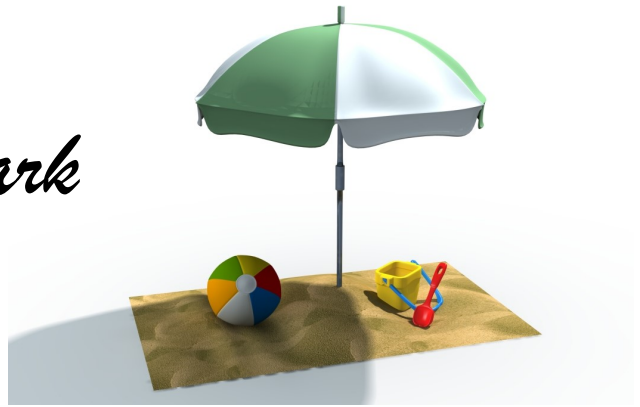


Stone Lake Beach

In Soldiers Memorial Park

Summer 2018



Lifeguards on duty from 10:30 a.m.-4 p.m. daily from May 26-August 14 (beach closed and no lifeguards on August 3). Concession stand open in beach house when beach guarded.

Beach Rules

- Park opens at sunrise and closes at 10 p.m. (patrons must leave the park by 10 p.m.)
- **SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK!** The City of La Porte Park and Recreation Department does not assume liability for injury or for damaged, lost or stolen property.
- Swim in guarded area —designated by orange buoys —when lifeguards are on duty.
- Adult supervision required for all non-swimmers and youth at all times.
- Lifeguards may require proof of swimming ability.
- No playing or pulling on buoys allowed.
- Alcoholic beverages, smoking, vaping or use of any tobacco product prohibited in the Family Section (designated by signage along the beach).
- No glass containers allowed in park.
- No pets allowed on beach area.
- No littering, graffiti or destruction of property allowed in park. **KEEP YOUR PARK CLEAN!**
- No ground fires or grilling allowed in park except in places provided for such purposes.
- No motorized vehicles except for designated parking areas.
- No overnight parking or camping allowed in park.
- Chairs and tables are not allowed in water.
- City noise ordinances enforced.
- Profanity, vulgarity, improper behavior and intoxication are prohibited.
- Horseplay, throwing sand or rocks and other such behaviors are prohibited.
- No sitting or standing on the lifeguard towers allowed.
- Feeding water fowl prohibited on all park properties.
- Hunting prohibited on all park properties.
- No boats allowed in the swimming area (may be beached in areas at discretion of lifeguards). Boats may only be launched in designated areas. Boats traveling parallel to the shore must maintain a minimum distance of 200 feet from the buoys.
- Lifeguards have authority to enforce or modify rules as needed to ensure public safety.
