

While the start of spring and warmer days to come is certainly exciting, it is important not to overlook what comes with an increase in seasonal rain stormwater pollution. Stormwater either soaks into exposed soil or remains on top of surfaces like rooftops and asphalt. Most stormwater will eventually evaporate, but often times it will flow as runoff to another location, picking up pollutants on its way. Here are some tips to help prevent stormwater pollution this spring.



#### **Keep Grass Clippings On Your Lawn**

Here are some tips to help recycle grass clippings for healthy waterways.

- Cut grass when it is dry
- Use a sharp mower blade and do not cut more then 1/3 of the grass blade.
- Keep grass mowed to between 2-3"
- If the grass is to high, you can mow over clippings to make them smaller and spread them out further on the lawn
- When mowing along a sidewalk or street be sure the blower is facing back towards the lawn

### **Scoop the Poop**

Pet waste left on the ground, especially near streets and sidewalks, gets washed into the storm drains during rain events and flows to your local waterways without being treated!

Pet waste contributes to bacterial contamination of our rivers, lakes and streams. Pet waste contains nutrients that can cause excessive algae growth. As pet waste decomposes it demands a high level of oxygen from the water which can harm fish and plant life.
