

URGENT FILING DATES FOR LAPORTE ENTERPRISE ZONE BUSINESSES

- April 15 Indiana Schedule EZ Parts 1A through 3 for Year 2023 are due with your Indiana state tax return. The Indiana Department of Revenue in cooperation with the Internal Revenue Service approves extensions.

- May 15 Deadline for filing the Form EZ-2, accompanied by a copy of the current year Business Tangible Personal Property Assessment Return (Form 102 or 103). File in duplicate with the LaPorte County Auditor for new personal and real property investments as of January 1, 2024.

- May 15 Deadline to request an extension of up to 30 days to file Year 2023 Business Tangible Personal Property Assessment Return (Form 102 or 103) from your County Auditor.

- June 1 Business Registration (EZB-R) for La Porte Enterprise Zone

- June 15 Form 102 or 103 is due to the LaPorte County Auditor with a copy of the approved extension from the County Assessor.

- July 15 If an extension is received, Form EZB-R is due.

REMINDER: If you are in the enterprise zone and a TIF (tax increment financing district), you must receive authorization from the La Porte Redevelopment Commission before submitting an EZ-2 to the county auditor.
