#### Claims Approval

#### **Department Head Reports**

**Water:** Water Director Tim Werner stated their Scada updates will be finished by the end of the month. He also noted they turned the cost of the damaged generator into insurance, and they are working with Nies Engineering to get the bids ready for the new well construction in Solider Memorial Park.

**L.E.A.P.:** Executive Director of La Porte Economics Advancement Partnership Bert Cook noted they have a new Child Care Voucher Program. This program is designed for those who are looking to re-enter the workforce and need help with Child Care. The program gives a voucher for \$50 towards Child Care needs. For information contact the Workforce Development Coordinator Eric Nelson.

**Street/Code:** Director of Central Services Jeff Batchelor stated the Street Department are working on putting in guardrails, patching, removing tree stumps and tree limps. The Code Department is still moving along with violations.

**Transporte:** Transporte Manager Beth West stated that if we get inclement weather, they will be running slower or close early.

**Fire:** Fire Chief Andy Snyder stated they will be conducting Ice Rescue Training and noted they have three firefighters out due to Covid.

**HR:** Human Resource Jen Noll stated she is working on annual reports and interviews. Job opportunities are listed on the City's website.

**Sewage:** Wastewater Director Jerry Jackson stated they are talking with Surf Air and getting the plant hooked up.

**Communications:** Communications Director Jess Bruder stated there was a nice turn out for the Marine NIBC Basketball Tournament and noted she is still working the bugs out of the website.

**Engineering:** City Engineer Nick Minich stated they had a Clear Lake Loop Design Workshop; Street Paving will go out for bid Friday or Monday and there is an addendum to the Troyer Contract for the Park Street Project.

Park: Park Director Mark Schreiber stated that Youth Sports Registration is going on for Boys Baseball, Tennis, T-Ball and Girls Softball. The Ice Rink will open this Friday and run through February 21st and Winterfest will be the last weekend of January.

**Planning:** Community Development & Planning Director Craig Phillips stated he is working on some residential projects that will be going out for public offering.

## **Contract with Wessler Engineering**

Wastewater Director Jackson presented a contract with Wessler Engineering for technical support with Stormwater issues with a cap of \$20,000 a year.

Mr. Kosior moved to approve the Contract with Wessler Engineering as presented; motion seconded by Ms. Romine and motion passed with the following roll call: Mayor Dermody-Aye, Ms. Romine-Aye and Mr. Kosior-Aye.

Wastewater Director Jackson introduced Joe Peters from Nies Engineering who worked on the design for the Phosphorus Project.

#### **Phosphorus Bids**

Wastewater Director Jackson stated they received three bids for the Phosphorus Project, and he is asking the Board to award to KDM Services in the amount of \$1,745,000. He noted the third addendum was missing, but it is not worth rejecting the bid.

Mr. Kosior moved to award the Phosphorus Project to KDM Services as presented; motion seconded by Ms. Romine and motion passed with the following roll call: Mayor Dermody-Aye, Ms. Romine-Aye and Mr. Kosior-Aye.

## Renewable Wastewater Hauler Permit

Wastewater Director Jackson presented a renewal for a Wastewater Hauler Permit for Sunset Septic and Excavating.

Mr. Kosior moved to approve the Renewable Wastewater Hauler Permit as presented; motion seconded by Mayor Dermody and motion passed with the following roll call vote: Mayor Dermody-Aye, Mr. Kosior-Aye and Ms. Romine abstained.

## **Contract Amendment for Park Street Project**

City Engineer Nick Minich stated the first design for the Park Street Project was a simple resurface. The amendment is to add an intersection improvement at McClung, Park and Bach Streets with a roundabout and a right of way acquisition. The first design cost was \$97,500 and now the contract with the amendment is in the amount of \$280,430.00. This is an 80/20 grant with our portion coming out of the Major Moves Fund. The Construction date is set for 2024.
