



City of La Porte Historic Preservation Commission Meeting Minutes

A meeting of the City of La Porte Historic Preservation Commission ("Commission") was held at City Hall Council Chambers, 801 Michigan Avenue, La Porte, IN, 46350 on Tuesday, December 17, 2024 at 5:30 P.M.
